This new edition of the Revista Paranaense de Desenvolvimento features the theme of planning and territorial development in its Dossier section, organized by Dr. Eliseu Raphael Venturi, holds a bachelor's degree in law from Centro Universitário Curitiba (UNICURITIBA) and a post-doctorate in Law and New Technologies from Mediterranea International Center for Human Rights Research, in Regio Callabria, Italy. Eliseu was editor of a scientific journal at UFPR, is a researcher in the field of human rights and produces opinion articles, as well as acting as a reviewer for nacional and internacional journals.

The Dossier highlights important aspects of the process of thinking, planning and interacting with local development dynamics. There are ten articles dedicated to the conceptual and metodological verification of the theme and also to its concatenation with the Brazilian and Paraná realities.

In parallel, the journal presents four articles on a variety of subjects. In the first topic, the author Joana Silva deals with the distributive issue in the Northeast of the country, verifying the effects of the COVID pandemic and government aid on the concentration of income in the Northeastern states. In the environmental field, Cassiane Gris Basso and Cristiano Stamm assess the relationship between economic growth with renewable energy and CO2 emissions in Brasil, using econometrics over the last three decades.

On the regional level, Daniela Ragazzon and Marcio Marconato explore the socio-economic implications of the SUSAF-PR program based on its application to cheese factories in the Southwest of Paraná. Finally, the authors José Elmar Feger, João Eugenio Marynovski, Evita Dorothy Botta and Maria de Fátima Albuquerque Caracristi analyze the tourist experience in a natural attraction in the state of Tocantins by collecting and processing qualitative information recorded by visitors.
